

## **Adverts for School-Community Partnerships for Education (SCOPE) project proposal**

USAID recently issued a call for the School-Community Partnerships for Education (SCOPE) project with the primary purpose of improving literacy outcomes for children in primary grades. School learning is enhanced by supportive home environments and communities, and ensuring the provision of quality education and high level of student learning is a community issue that extends beyond the classroom and formal education structures. By fostering partnerships between schools and the broader community, SCOPE will lead to greater engagement by education stakeholders to support schools and improve student literacy skills. SCOPE will consist of three interrelated core activities: 1) Strengthen the capacity of school leadership to improve student literacy through school-community partnerships; 2) Increase effective community and parental involvement to improve literacy skills; 3) Foster a culture of reading. Save the Children, a global leader in implementing state-of-the-art education programs focused on basic education, non-formal education, school health and nutrition, and early childhood development, is preparing a proposal for SCOPE and is seeking a Chief of Party and a Technical Advisor.
