#### Purpose of the study

RENCP wishes to help build the capacity of the local NGOs so that they can start efficiently and effectively **in** contributing to the development of the education sector in Rwanda and to secure:

- Increased communication, cooperation, strategic planning, and joint action between NGOs and INGOs.
- Increased interaction between NGO's in Education with emphasis on content and geographical complementarities.
- Joint monitoring & experience sharing.

### Methodology

We shall combine interdisciplinary qualitative methods and approaches in the collection and analysis of data. The bulk of the data to be collected shall be through fieldwork carried out in Kigali and upcountry.

- 1) Focus Group Discussions (FGDs) with various categories of target groups and participants associated with RENCP
- 2) In-depth key interviews (KII) with various stakeholders associated with RENCP

This shall be supplemented by participant discussions of their challenges and observations.

The two methods of data collection are, in our view, most suitable qualitative approaches for the study because people we shall interview are active participants who can make their own observations and point out some of the challenges and constraints as well as opportunities in the fulfillment of their mandates.

A sustainable mechanism that helps NGOs efficiently and effectively contributing to the development of the education sector in Rwanda.
