# Member Achievements



## VSO

- Conducted 6-day training for TTCs in English, Math and Language methods for instructors on new curriculum. 142 tutors participated
- Training for Principals and Deputy principals planned
- Organized English Language Assessment Technical Working Group to support the development of English Diagnostic tools
- Awarded new DFID Innovation Fund Project- Achieving Learning Outcomes for All

- Started Umubano Primary School-Nursery to P6

## British Council

- Finalizing findings from sampling of teachers English proficiency levels
- School linking project continues
- Involved in initiative for coordinating school leadership with REB and other NGOs
- Awarded new DFID Innovation Fund grant looking at self study tools for teachers English acquisition



# Member Achievements (Cont.)



## Wellspring Foundation

- Organized sector based training in Gasabo District-all teachers in district were involved.
- School development survey was conducted and School Development Program (SDP) is still going on in 48 public schools of Gasabo District.
- Two Phases of Personal development workshop for SEOs was conducted and the final phase is being organized.

## EDC/L3

- Launched materials distribution to 90 schools in 5 districts
- Facilitating development of resources and tools for School Based Mentorship program as well as recruitment of mentors and assignments

## International Education Exchange

- Finalizing School-based mentorship training manual and accompanying videos

## Aegis Trust/Kigali Genocide Memorial

- Delivered 24 workshops to teachers and students about genocide education. Workshops help teachers address Rwandan History with a focus on genocide.
