QUICK OVERVIEW OF SINAPISI-RWANDA NGO RWANDA'S IMPACT THROUGH THE CONSISTENT SUPPORT OF OUR PARTNERS AND FRIENDS:

Community Health Programme:

- 111 Cooperatives of Community Health Workers (CHW) supported
- **30,000 people** accessed health care and nutrition support

Cooperatives and Gender Promotion:

- **4414** (mostly women) impacted through our Cooperatives and gender promotion in Kicukiro and Gasabo Districts.
- **3840** Groups Leaders trained on gender mainstreaming
- 250 ISGLs (Internal Saving and Lending Groups) were supported

Family integration of Orphans:

- **300** children were integrated into families
- 3,000 orphaned and vulnerable children supported

Agriculture:

- **35,000** households received seeds and small livestock
- **104** farmer field school received training





To achieve these impacts and more SINAPISI-RWANDA NGO has worked with different partners including MOH/Global fund (CCM-Rwanda) in HIV/AIDS, and Malaria prevention, family planning and impact mitigation for vulnerable groups. SINAPISI-RWANDA NGO also worked in partnership with USAID/Global Communities in the HIGA/UBEHO program- in the field of HIV and Health promotion, Orphans and Vulnerable Children, Economic Strengthening, Food Security, and Nutrition; Catholic Relief Services also supported activities in Nutrition. The German based NGO-KBF e.V. & Rhenanie Palatinat supported activities in Education. KBF e.V. also supports activities on Orphans and Foster Families. WDA supports in Technical and Vocational Education and Training; GLIA in HIV prevention and Agriculture, while World Connect supports vulnerable women (street vendors in economic strengthening.

It is in that regard that SINAPISI-RWANDA NGO in partnership with Rwanda NGOs Forum on HIV/AIDS & Health Promotion and plans to hold a community empowerment salute with Partners and stakeholders. The event will bring together representatives from Government, CSOs, Private sector, Development partners, Finance Institution and Research Institutions.
